What is a water pill, exactly?

Water pills, or **diuretics**, help rid the body of excess fluid by increasing **urine production and elimination** when we use the bathroom.

Why are water pills important?

To answer that, let's take a couple steps back first.

Most of us have experienced excess fluid in the body in the form of swelling of the lower legs and feet. Maybe we sat too long in one position while watching TV or attending a social function.

Whatever the scenario, we know instinctively that swelling is out of the norm and undesirable. We also recognize that getting our shoes off and elevating or "icing" our legs is an effective way to help get rid of the fluid.

When doctors prescribe water pills (or diuretics) it is sometimes for persistent swelling (called edema) of the lower legs. But there are other

important reasons too, including to lower blood pressure, manage liver or kidney diseases, or to treat congestive heart disease that may cause excess fluid buildup in the lungs.

But no matter the reason, if your doctor has prescribed a diuretic, it's important to take your water pill as directed.
